Do I need a Will and how do I create one?

A Will is a legal document that sets out how the things you own will be distributed when you pass away and is the only way to ensure your wishes will be honoured. It is also a wonderful way to remember and provide for the people and causes you care about.

Some people tend to overlook the importance of making a Will or think it is too difficult. Everyone should have a Will to ensure the people you love, and the charitable causes you care about, are looked after when you are gone.

To make or update your Will we recommend speaking to a qualified legal professional. They will ensure your Will is valid and your intentions will be carried out.

How to leave a gift in your Will

It's easy to remember Yalari in your Will. You can include the gift to Yalari when you write your Will or simply add one as a clause (a codicil) to your existing Will. There a number of options you can consider when including a bequest in your Will.

Percentage Share

This allows you to allocate a share or percentage of your estate to your nominated beneficiaries. When making your Will you do not need to know how much your estate will be worth, just what size share you wish to leave to each beneficiary.

Suggested clause:

I wish to leave a percentage of my estate to Yalari Limited, Unit 5/62 Siganto Drive, Helensvale QLD 4212 as follows;

I direct my executors to divide the residue of my Estate, both real and personal, into one hundred shares and I GIVE _____ shares to Yalari Limited (the company) to be applied for the general purposes thereof and I DECLARE that the receipt from the Executive Officer or other proper officer of the company shall be a full and sufficient discharge to my Trustee for the payment of the said sum and that my Trustee shall not be bound to see to the application thereof.

Personal Property or Real Estate

This allows you to particular items, including personal property or real estate.

Suggested clause:

I wish to leave personal property or real estate to Yalari Limited, Unit 5/62 Siganto Drive, Helensvale QLD 4212 as follows;

I GIVE AND BEQUEATH the following items of my property and effects _____ to Yalari Limited (the company) to be applied for the general purposes thereof and I DECLARE that the receipt from the Executive Officer or other proper officer of the company shall be a full and sufficient discharge to my Trustee for the payment of the said sum and that my Trustee shall not be bound to see to the application thereof.

A Pecuniary Gift

This is a specific dollar amount that you wish to leave to Yalari. It could be any amount you wish.

Suggested clause:

I wish to leave a sum of money to Yalari Limited, Unit 5/62 Siganto Drive, Helensvale QLD 4212 as follows;

I GIVE AND BEQUEATH free of all duties death estate succession or otherwise payable in consequence of my death the sum of \$_____ to Yalari Limited (the company) to be applied for the general purposes thereof and I DECLARE that the receipt from the Executive Officer or other proper officer of the company shall be a full and sufficient.

Gifts to establish a Scholarship/Bursary

You may wish to leave a specific gift in order to establish a Scholarship/Bursary.

Suggested clause:

I bequeath to Yalari Limited, Unit 5/62 Siganto Drive, Helensvale QLD 4212 the sum of \$_____ to be held by Yalari Limited to be known as _____ Scholarship/Bursary.
